CIRCULAR

Subject: Submission of choice of electives (four choices in decreasing order of preference) from the available list.


1. The National Medical Commission (NMC) regulations on Graduate Medical Education- 2019 Part-II for MBBS course, effective from the academic Year 2019-20 onwards, have created an opportunity in the MBBS Programme for students to do electives, with the aim to stimulate enquiry, self-directed experiential learning and lateral thinking among students.
2. It is mandatory for the learners to do two electives of two weeks each (one in each block). This One month is designated for elective rotations after completion of the examination at the end of Third MBBS Part I and before commencement of Third MBBS part II.
3. It is mandatory for learners to do an elective and the elective time shall not be used to make up for missed clinical postings, shortage of attendance or other purposes.
4. Minimum 75% of attendance in the each of the two blocks of electives and submission of log book maintained during both the blocks is required for eligibility to appear in the final MBBS examination.
5. During First Month, Roll Nos. 1-85 shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 86-170 shall undergo electives in clinical subjects.
During Second Month, it shall be vice versa, i.e. Roll Nos. 1-85 shall undergo electives in clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 86-170 shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects
6. In this context, the institution/department-wise list of the available electives has been prepared and displayed in the academic section.
7. All MBBS students who are currently pursuing Third MBBS part-I are hereby directed to submit their choice of electives (four choices in decreasing order of preference) as per the enclosed proforma (at Annexure-I).
8. The duly filled scanned copy of the proforma in PDF format should be submitted either in hard copy or through email to the following Email Id latest by 27th October (7:00 pm): principal@vmmc-sjh.nic.in

9. Though every effort shall be made for the allotment of electives as per the order of preference submitted by the student, however, the same cannot be guaranteed.
10. Allotment of electives to students will be done on 28th and 29th of October 2022 as follows:


