7. Crucial date for determination of eligibility with reference to Age & Educational qualification will be the last date of submission of online application. The result of PG should be declared on or before the last date of submission of online application. In case of DNB, the result of both i.e. theory and practical should be declared on or before the last date of submission of online application. If the result of PG will be declared after last date of submission of online application, candidate will not be eligible for the post of Senior Resident.
8. All the candidates may be allowed to appear in written examination on the basis of declaration in the online application without scrutiny of their application. If any ineligibility is detected at any stage of selection process or during tenure, his/her candidature will be cancelled / withdrawn.
9. PG tenure completion date would be on or before 31.01.2026.
10. The tenure of Senior Resident is three years including any service rendered earlier as Senior Resident on adhoc/regular basis in any Govt. of India/State Government hospital/institution. The appointment will be initially for a period of one year, which could be extended for a period of total three years on an annual basis, subject to the satisfactory work & conduct report from the concerned HOD.
11. Other service conditions will be applicable as per service conditions prescribed from time to time by the Govt. of India.
12. The candidate who is already employed should submit No Objection Certificate from present employer at the time of assessment/Interview.
13. Inter - hospital/Institution transfer shall not be permitted.
