G.S.R. 124.—In pursuance of sub-rule (1), and the first proviso to sub-rule (2), of rule 4 of the Indian Administrative Service (Cadre) Rules, 1954, the Central Government in consultation with the Government of Andhra Pradesh, hereby make the following further amendments in the I.A.S. (Fixation of Cadre Strength) Regulations, 1955.

#### Amendments

In the Schedule to the said Regulations, for the entries relating to "ANDHRA PRADESH", the following shall be substituted, namely:—

**G.S.R. 149.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 4 and sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 (37 of 1954), the Central Government after consultation with the Central Committee for Food Standards, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules, 1955, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (1) of section 23 of the said Act, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the prevention of Food Adulteration (Amendment) Rules, 1962.

2. In the prevention of Food Adulteration Rules, 1955, in Appendix B after item A.11.04, the following item shall be inserted, namely:—

"A.11.04.01. Double Toned milk means the product prepared by blending milk with

- (a) fresh separated milk; or
- (b) separated milk reconstituted from spray dried skim milk powder; or
- (c) by partial abstraction of fat through skimming or separation of milk;

and containing not less than 1.5 per cent of milk fat and 10 per cent of milk solids other than milk fat."

**G.S.R. 150.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Safdarjang and Willingdon Hospital & Nursing Home and Contributory Health Service Scheme (Accounts Officer) Recruitment Rules 1962.

2. **Application.**—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed thereto.

3. **Number, classification, scale of pay etc.**—The number and classification of posts and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. **Nature, age limit, qualifications, method of recruitment etc.**—The nature, age limit, qualifications, method of recruitment and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule:

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of Government servants and in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes or displaced persons and other special categories in accordance with the general instructions issued from time to time by the Central Government.

5. **Disqualification.**—(a) No person who has more than one wife living, or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to any post referred to in column 1 of the said Schedule and (b) no woman whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has

a wife living at the time of such marriage shall be eligible for appointment to any post referred to in column 1 of the aforesaid Schedule;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
