General instructions and mandatory guidelines for MBBS Students Fresh Batch 2020

- 1. All students must carry a negative RT-PCR report which should not be earlier than 72 hours, prior to the date of joining.
- 2. Installation & display of Arogya Setu App shall be mandatory.
- 3. All students must wear a mask.
- 4. Respiratory etiquettes are to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
- 5. Physical distancing to be followed as far as feasible.
- 6. Practice frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 30-40 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty
- 7. Use alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds).
- 8. Self-monitoring of health and reporting any illness at the earliest to the warden/ designated nodal officer
- 9. Sharing of stationary etc will not be allowed.
- 10. Temperature screening will be mandatory before being allowed into the hostel/college.
- 11. Student with any symptoms INFLUENZA LIKE ILLNESS (like fever, cough, sore throat, malaise & diarrhea) will not be allowed to re-join/enter into hostel.
- 12. All the hostelers who stay in Delhi will commute on a daily basis for the time being. Only Students from outside from Delhi will be allowed to stay in hostel after they display the Fitness Certificate issued after screening.
- 13. Hostelers who develop symptoms after joining will be kept in isolation in pre-designated rooms in boys' and girls' hostel until their TRUE-NAT/ RT PCR report is ready (Action, Girls and Boys hostel wardens).

- 14. Dr Sameer Gulati, Associate Professor, Dept of Medicine will be the designated as Nodal Officer for coordination regarding re-joining of students and Dr Rupali Malik, Associate Professor, Dept of Medicine will look after his work in his absence.
